

## **MORGANA MINI**


This mini pattern is an expansion of the Morgana Quilt, and utilizes the quarter circle cutout blocks from Step 2. This project requires ½ yard of additional background fabric, and finishes at 20" x 20".


FABRIC	REQUIREMENTS	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Background	½ yard	Cut 2 - 5" x WOF strips, subcut to 4 - 5" x 5" squares  12 - Template B, staggered as shown  Cut 1 - 2 ½" x WOF strip, subcut to 2 - 2 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles 1 - 2 ½" x 20 ½" rectangle
Binding	⅓ yard	Cut 3 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips
Backing	⅔ yard	Cut <b>1</b> - 24" x 24" square




1) Trim the leftover quarter circle blocks from the full Morgana pattern if needed using **Template A**. Then, sew these blocks to the **Template B** pieces. Press away from the **Template B** pieces to create the number and orientations of **Quarter Circle Blocks** shown. Trim to 5" x 5", making sure to leave a 1/4" seam allowance along the background fabric as in the full Morgana pattern..













2) Sew together the **Quarter Circle Blocks** and the 5" x 5" background squares as shown in two different orientations. Press seams open, and repeat for four **Corner Blocks** each measuring 9 ½" × 9 ½".










3) Sew together the **Corner Blocks** with a 2 ½" x 9 ½" background rectangle in between as shown. Press open.









4) Sew together the blocks created in the previous step with a 2 ½" x 20 ½" rectangle in between as shown. Press open.
